

Eustace High School Cheerleader Tryouts 2012-2013

- *Tryouts for the Eustace Varsity Cheerleading Squad will be held Friday, March 9, 2012 @ 3:00 in the small high school gym.*
- *Practices will be held **March 5th, 6th, 7th** in small high school gym from 3:30-5:00.*
- *Parent meetings will be held on Tuesday, February 28th, 2012 @ 5:30 (and again Wednesday, February 29th @ 3:45 if needed) in the High School Library. It is mandatory that both candidate and parent attend one of these meetings.*

I. Tryout Qualifications

- A. Candidates must have an average of 70 or above in each class enrolled at the end of the six weeks prior to tryouts.**
- B. Candidates must attend school the day of tryouts.**
- C. Candidates must be in grades 8 - 11 to try out.**
- D. Candidates must submit an application and medical release form by deadline set forth by the coach or principal.**
- E. Candidates must attend 2 of the 3 practices prior to tryouts.**
- F. Candidates must perform a group cheer, a chant, an individual cheer, 3 jumps, and possibly a short dance.**
- G. Mascots must perform a skit (minimum length-2 min./maximum length-3 min.) displaying support for a Eustace Bulldog sports team.**

II. Tryout Application Denials

- A. A student who has been placed in AEP or is suspended from school during the current school year will not be permitted to tryout.**
- B. A student who has been assigned to ISS on three or more occasions during the current school year will not be permitted to tryout.**
- C. A student with an excessive amount of absences based on compulsory school attendance rules will not be permitted to tryout.**
- D. A student who was terminated or quit the squad the previous year may not tryout.**
- E. All UIL rules apply including House Bill 72, "no pass - no play."**
- F. An application can be denied if all the criteria are not met. If a candidate is deemed ineligible, an appeal may be submitted in writing to the campus principal.**
