

## **Child Find Notice**

**The Eustace Independent School District offers comprehensive special education services to eligible students ages 3 through 21 (birth through 21 for those with a visual or auditory impairment). Children from birth to age three with other disabilities will be referred to appropriate agencies for services. All referrals are confidential and services are provided at no cost. The parent retains the right to refuse services and will be afforded with all procedural safeguards provided under state and federal law.**

**Evaluations are provided for students in all areas of suspected disabilities, including learning disabilities, speech and language development, physical impairments, vision or hearing problems, developmental delays, emotional disturbance, autism, health impairments and traumatic brain injuries.**

**A free appropriate public education with a full continuum of services is available for qualifying students.
