To ensure success in third grade, the second grade student will:

- Use resource references such as a dictionary, glossary, or thesaurus
- Recognize and use parts of a book including table of contents, chapter titles, guide words, and indices
- Understand literary terms such as title, author, and illustrator
- Arrange words in alphabetical order
- Recognize compound words, base words, and inflections
- Retell sequence of events in a story
- Identify main idea and details in a story
- Compare and contrast two or more stories
- Recognize story characters, setting, and plot
- Use context clues to understand word meaning
- Analyze characters including traits, relationships, and changes
- Draw conclusions from gathered information
- Make inferences, draw conclusions, make predictions, and determine cause and effect
- Summarize text selections
- Identify purposes and differences of lists, newsletters, and signs
- Identify fact and fantasy
- Identify fiction and nonfiction texts
- Identify fact and opinion
- Determine purposes for listening and reading
- Interpret and read graphic aides such as maps, graphs, diagrams, and charts
- Identify rhymes, alliteration, and onomatopoeia
- Recognize features of stories, poems, and informational texts
- Interpret meanings of poetry
- Distinguish among antonyms, synonyms, and homophones
- Follow written and oral directions
- Read and comprehend grade level material independently
- Read with a fluency rate of 70 to 90 words per minute
