First Six Weeks

Recognizes numbers 0-20

Counts objects 0-20

Rote counts 0-50

Can write numbers 0-20

Can continue a two object pattern: (red, yellow, red, yellow)-AB

Can continue a two object pattern---ABB (red, yellow, yellow, red, yellow, yellow)

names the following shapes: circle square triangle rectangle

Second Six Weeks

Recognizes numbers 0-50

Counts objects 0-50

Rote counts 1-100

Can write numbers 0-50

Can continue a three object pattern---ABC (red, yellow, blue, red, yellow, blue)

uses words to describe positions:
over
above
under
below
on
near
before
after

Third Six Weeks

Recognizes numbers 0-100

Counts objects 1-100

Can write numbers 0-100

Can continue a four object pattern---AABB (red, red, yellow, yellow)

names the ordinal positions – first, second, third

Identify odd and even

Place value (tens and ones)

Fourth Six Weeks

Recognize and names whole and half

Construct graphs

Weight (heavier than, lighter than, equal to)

Fifth Six Weeks

Can complete addition problems using objects

Length (longer than, shorter than)

Name the following shapes: Sphere/ball Cube/box Cylinder/can Cone

Sixth Six Weeks

Capacity

Can complete subtraction problems using objects

Can name opposites: hot/cold high/low on/off

Recognize money (Identify penny, nickel, dime and quarter)
