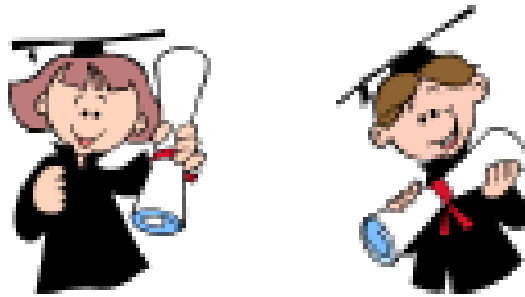


Kindergarten Math Graduate Profile



Recognizes numbers 0 through 20.

Counts objects 1 through 20.

Writes numbers 1 through 20.

Rote counts to 100.

Knows the four basic shapes: circle, square, triangle, and rectangle.

Can identify three dimensional shapes: sphere/ball, cube/box, cylinder/can, cone.

Can name and use the ordinal numbers first, second, third, fourth and fifth.

Can create and name AB, ABB, ABC, and AABB patterns.

Can use words to describe positions.

Can recognize and name whole and half (2 equal parts).

Can complete addition and subtraction problems using objects.

Can name opposites.

These minimum skills must be performed independently and consistently at school.
